A. TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Has at least a bachelor's degree with music background.
- 2. All staff and faculty of Peace that work with students unsupervised are subject to background checks and will be asked to fill out the authorization form.

B. ACCOUNTABILITY

The teacher is directly accountable to the principal.

C. JOB DESCRIPTION

The music teacher is responsible to:

- 1. Teach appropriate music curriculum for grades 5K-6.
- 2. Use effective techniques for motivating student interest in instructional activities.
- 3. Reinforce positive conduct and achievement by the pupils.
- 4. Enforce school regulations.
- 5. Use written and oral reports to effectively communicate with parents.
- 6. Participate in curriculum studies and other planning/study sessions intended for the faculty.
- Attend District conferences, assigned District conventions, leader's retreats, teacher in-service programs, and other special meetings as requested by the Principal.
- 8. Exemplify Christian behavior both in the classroom and in daily personal living.
- 9. Work with the principal to develop and execute a plan for personal professional growth.

D. ON DUTY TIME FOR MUSIC TEACHER

The Music Teacher will work a 15-hour week and schedule their time in coordination with the classroom teachers and Principal. Normally this means they will teach music two days a week for grades 5K-6.
